

SCHOOL UNIFORM

2026 - 2027

At Burford School, all students in Years 7–11 are expected to wear the school uniform, and accepting a place means agreeing to support this.

Uniform brings students together by creating a shared identity and sense of belonging.

Wearing uniform smartly shows personal pride and helps present a positive picture of the school in the community.

Keeping the uniform consistent supports our expectations for behaviour and learning, helping students stay focused and encouraging a respectful school environment.

Uniform items can be bought from several suppliers at a range of prices, giving families flexible options.

These expectations apply during the school day and while travelling to and from school, helping every student represent the school positively and consistently.

UNIFORM ITEMS

2026 - 2027

School Uniform - Compulsory Items

- Navy blazer branded with school logo
- Plain black school trousers (no jean/denim trousers, leggings or high fashion styles)

Or Black Pleated skirt - Full pleat styles, such as stitch-down pleats or knife pleats and made from

non-stretchy fabric.

Required skirt length is no less than one hand (fingers closed) above the knee.

- Plain white school shirt, long or short sleeved
- School tie branded in House Colours
- Dark coloured socks or neutral/black tights (no patterns or frills, or socks over tights)
- Shoes - Must be plain black, including sole, laces, and logos.

Material: Leather or leather-look material only.

Style: Smart, fully enclosed shoes with no decorative elements such as the metal lace tag or coloured logos.

School Uniform - Optional items

- Navy school V-neck jumper branded with school logo.
- Summer Uniform – Term 5 and Term 6 Only – White Polo branded with school logo

PE Kit – Compulsory items

- Navy PE sports short sleeved unisex polo top branded with school logo
- Navy PE sports shorts or skort
- Navy PE Mid-layer top branded with school logo
- Navy socks
- Trainers suitable for sports hall and astro turf and different to school shoes |

For some activities during the year.

- Gum shield and shin pads
- Football/rugby studded boots

PE Kit – Optional items

- Cricket Whites - Any brand - Students who represent the school at cricket will need a set or cricket white, students do not need whites for lessons in school
- Navy Tracksuit Bottoms – branded with school logo

GENERAL APPEARANCE

Hair

- Style and colour must be appropriate for school,
- No shaved patterns or designs
- Normal hair colour dyes are acceptable
- Long hair should be tied back, this is essential in laboratories, technology areas and for sport

Jewellery

- One small stud earring in each ear (no hoops, dangly earrings, or stretchers)
- One discreet ring (must not be distracting or oversized)
- No facial or body piercings (including nose, eyebrow, lip or tongue piercings). Clear studs are not permitted
- No visible necklaces (unless for religious or medical reasons, and must be worn under clothing)

Makeup Guidelines 7-11

Any makeup should be minimal and natural-looking.

- Students may wear: Light foundation or concealer
- Subtle mascara or eyebrow grooming

Items that are not allowed:

- Heavy eyeliner, bold eyeshadow, or lipstick
- False eyelashes or false nails
- Nail polish
- Visible contouring or dramatic makeup styles
